Boy Scout Reporting Procedures

For a Scout related report, contact your Professional Scouter or Scout Executive, Trip Selman at work (800) 699-8806 ext. 108. For reports of activities not related to Scouts, call the Department of Family and Children's Services in your local community.

For Scout related reports do not talk to the media. The Scout Executive is the official BSA spokesman. Let him answer all the questions. Do not discuss details with other individuals until the Council has completed

a thorough investigation. Thank you.

The Three Rs of Youth Protection

- **Recognize** strategies and situations used by molesters that can lead to attempted molestation. Remember – a child molester can be anyone.
- **Resist** attempts of child molesters, since few resort to force. Resistance will stop most attempts at molestation.
- **Report** individuals who attempt to molest you to your parents or other trusted adults. This helps to protect other young people and provide an opportunity for the molester to get help
